PRESENTATIONS, PRIZES & MORE

All entrants will be honored at a special ceremony at the Brooklyn Peace Fair on Sunday, October 22nd. One winner from each age group in each expression category will receive a \$100 savings bond. The three age groups for the judging are Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, Grades 9-12.

Winners of the Essay contest will present their essays at the Peace Fair, all artwork submitted will be on display at the Fair, and rap entrants will compete live on October 22nd.

• ESSAY •

Essays may be neatly handwritten or typed. Essays for grades three through five must be 150 words or less. Essays for grades six through eight must be 300 words or less. Essays for grades nine through twelve must be 300 words or more.

• ART •

Artwork can be 2 or 3 dimensional, no larger than 30 inches high or wide. Please include a title of your work. If the artwork is abstract in design, please indicate which side is up.

• RAP •

Must be an original work of three minutes or less; can be performed with props, costumes or musical accompaniment.
